## ARTICLES Using A and An

**Articles** are a part of speech. They are three small words we use everyday. **A, an** and **the** might be tiny, but they do a big job. Articles are also adjectives and point to a noun. If you see an article, you know a noun is sure to follow.

The can be used with singular nouns or plural nouns. Look at these examples:

**The** *boy* rode his bike.

The boys rode their bikes.

A and **an** are only used with singular nouns. A good rule to remember is that **A** is used before words that begin with a consonant. **An** is used before words that begin with vowels - a, e, i, o, or u.

**A** boy rode his bike.

**An** *apple* is good to eat.

Look at the nouns below. If the noun needs **a** in front of it, write **A**. If it needs **an** in front of it, write **An**.
