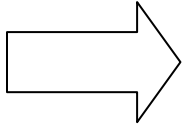


## Adjectives

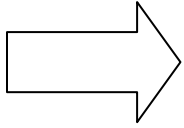

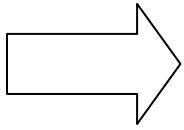
