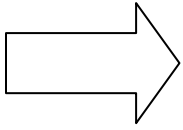

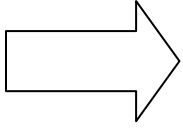

Future = will happen some day

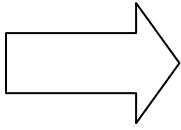
