There are four kinds of sentences:

- 1. Telling sentences tell us something or state a fact.
- 2. Asking sentences ask a question.
- 3. Exclamatory sentences show excitement.
- 4. Command sentences command or tell someone to do something.

There are two things to remember about **Command sentences**:

- 1. Always begin with a **capital letter** and end with a **period**.
- 2. When writing command sentences, it is often polite to begin with the word please.
