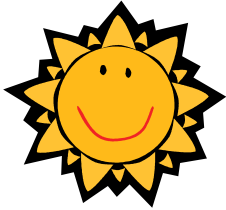


Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow – Measurements of Time

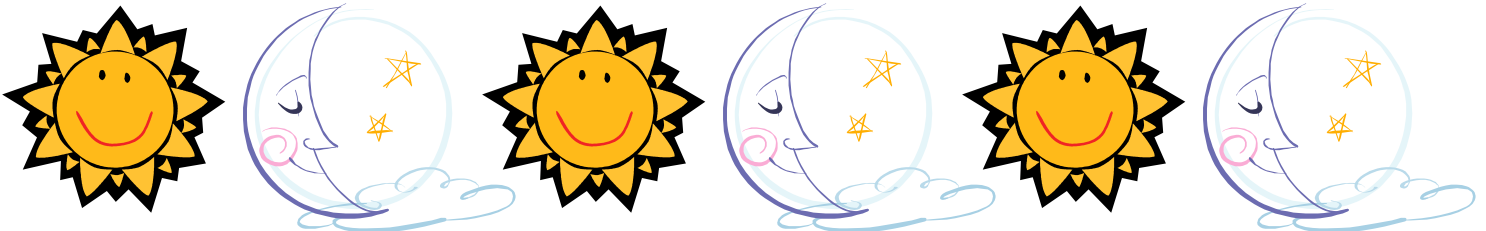


We all know that when the sun shines it is daytime. The **day** is divided into **morning** and **afternoon**. Morning is everything that happens before lunch time (12 o'clock). Afternoon is everything that happens after lunch time. Think of some of the things you do during the day. What happens in the morning? What happens in the afternoon?



After the sun goes down, we can see the moon and the stars. This time is called **night**. Nights are longer in winter and shorter in summer. What do you do at night?

When we talk about **today**, we are talking about what is happening now. **Yesterday** is the day before today and **tomorrow** is the day after today. Here they are:

Last night

Today

Tonight

Tomorrow

Tomorrow night

B. Storytime

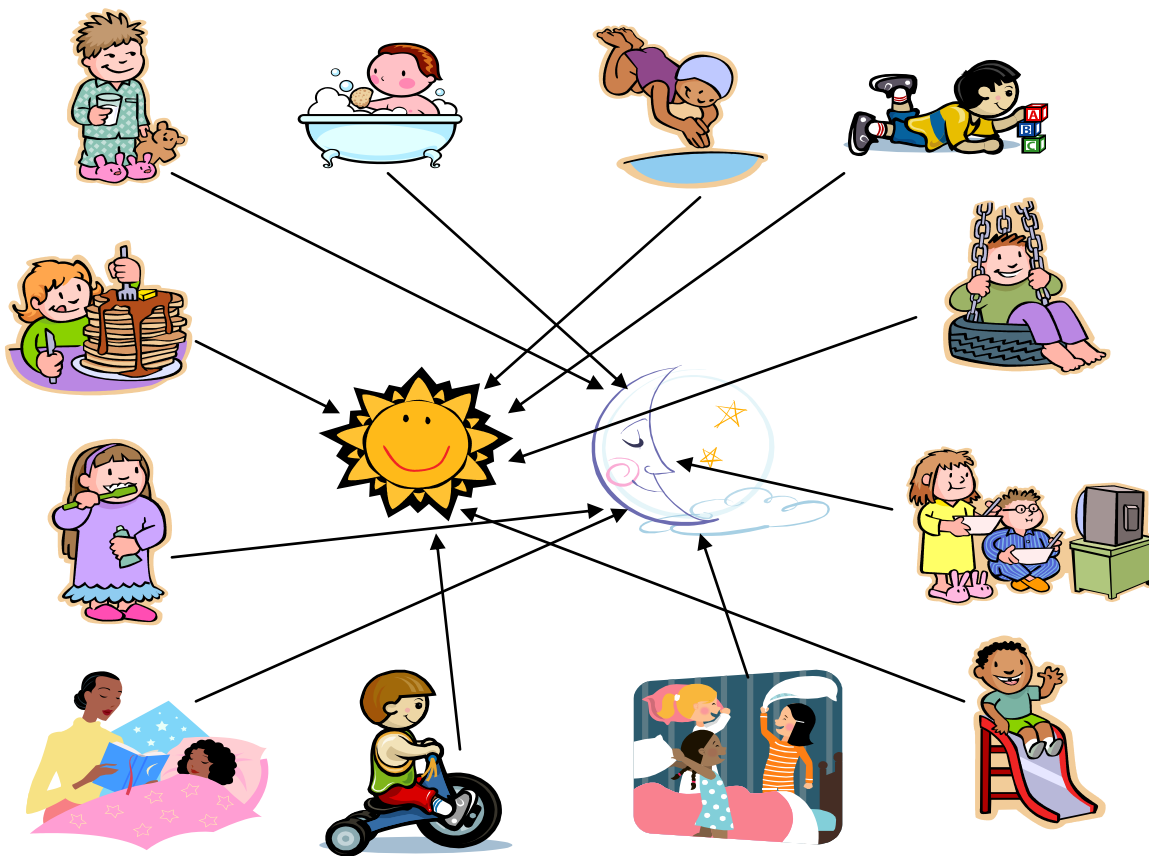
