## Say When Using Past, Present and Future Tense Verbs

## **Reading and Discussion**

**Verbs** are action words. They tell us about an **action** or a **state of being**. **Tense** tells us when the action takes place.

There are three **verb tenses** that we can use:

- 1. **Present tense verbs** tell us what is happening **now**.
  - Janet chops the celery for salad.

**Chops** tells us the action is happening now.

- **2. Past tense verbs** tell us what happened in the **past**. This could be anytime from five seconds ago to a thousand years ago.
  - Janet chopped the celery for salad.

**Chopped** tells us the action happened in the past.

- **3. Future tense verbs** are actions that will happen in the **future**.
  - Janet will chop the celery for salad later.

**Will chop** tells us the action will happen in the future. Most of the time when you use future tense, you use the helping verb **will** in front of the verb.
